Tasting Notes:

This wine is made from 100% Mencia grapes, selected on the vine and aged five months in new French and American oak, to achieve an optimal balance between wood and wine. The bright ruby color with bluish notes shows its youth. The nose is intense and complex with primary aromas of ripe and candied fruits and delightful hints of raisins, toasted coffee and licorice. The palate is powerful but elegant, with a long and rounded finish. Robert Parker rated 88 points.

Recommendation: decanter 10-15 minutes.
